7:30 pm Luna Star Cover CASH ONLY	In August 2020 writer, guitarist and vocalist Walter Parks was invited by The Library of Congress to archive his research on and perform his arrangements of music made by southeast Georgia's Okefinokee Swamp homesteaders – hollers, hymns and reels. For 10 years Parks, a Florida native, served as the sideman guitarist to Woodstock Festival legend Richie Havens. Now based out of St. Louis, Walter has recently co-written with Stan Lynch, former Tom Petty drummer, a single released with his Americana spirituals project called The Unlawful Assembly co-founded by drummer Steven WilliamsWalter also tours with his own trio Swamp Cabbage and with his solo show Swamp ByChandelier. www.walterparks.com
Dec 6	Billy Livesey
8 pm	Born in Washington DC, Billy was raised in South Florida and graduated from Hialeah High School.
Luna Star	After seeing "The Beatles" and "The Rolling Stones", Billy knew exactly what he wanted to do.
Cover	After high school at the age of 17 he cut his guitar and singing chops by first touring the country with a soul band and then various rock bands.
CASH	In the spring of 1998, Billy got the job, playing lead guitar and sharing the singing duties with "E Streeter Clarence Clemons". The band called "The Temple Of Soul" released 2
ONLY	albums "Live In Asbury Park, Volume 1" and "Live in Asbury Park, Volume 2" featuring Bruce Springsteen. He played with Clarence until his passing in 2011.
	Currently a respected member of the music community, Billy devotes his time singing and playing guitar with founding member of "Savoy Brown and Foghat" bassist Tony Stevens, as well as his own band "The Livesays".
	Billy has forged a national career which includes: the licensing of 21 songs to an MTV series, and publishing deals with Kid Gloves Music, Transition Music and Crucial Music.
	Billy has placed songs in Motion pictures, NBC movies of the week and dozens of weekly television shows.





Joel Zoss has enjoyed a worldwide reputation as a songwriter and guitarist since Bonnie Raitt recorded his "Too Long at the Fair" and "I Gave My Love a Candle." Featuring his own million-selling compositions and folk and blues classics by American masters such as Elizabeth Cotten, Lead Belly, and Big Bill Broonzy, Zoss's unique fingerpicking style and moving vocals have entertained audiences from blues clubs and concert halls to the Philadelphia Folk Festival. From 2007-2009 he opened shows for B.B. King and Etta James in theaters across the country. He has performed and recorded with many highly regarded artists including David Bromberg, Taj Mahal, James Taylor, Paul Butterfield, and Howlin' Wolf.
