Lee Hunter and Joey Kerr

Lee Hunter is a singer, songwriter, rhythm guitarist, percussionist and pianist with a passion for folklore. From 1992-2014, she worked with guitarist Arvid Smith in the critically acclaimed duo, Tammerlin. Together they placed their own stamp on folk/roots music. What you heard was exceptional guitar work accompanying clever original songs and traditional tunes pulled from the roots of American music.

Since 2015, Lee has been working with outstanding guitarist and award-winning songwriter, Joey Kerr. Joey brings impressive musicianship and an extensive knowledge of American music to the duo's sound. In addition, Lee and Joey offer an educational program for students of all ages and two special concerts of music and spoken word- a holiday program, "Wintersong- A Celebration of the Winter Season" and "Civil War & Seafaring Songs". Lee & Joey are joined from time to time by keyboardist, Walter Mingledorff as Lee Hunter & The Gatherers Trio.

Lee's focus remains on performing and writing songs. Together with Walter Parks, longtime guitarist for Richie Havens and a fine songwriter and solo performer, were asked to open to open a series of shows for Emmylou Harris in 2015. They have since performed at several music festivals and plan to continue to collaborate from time to time. Walter Parks has also played at the cafe before and returns on a yearly basis.





Luna Star Presents Joel Zoss

Joel Zoss has enjoyed a worldwide reputation as a songwriter and guitarist since Bonnie Raitt recorded his "Too Long at the Fair" and "I Gave My Love a Candle." Featuring his own million-selling compositions and folk and blues classics by American masters such as Elizabeth Cotten, Lead Belly, and Big Bill Broonzy, Zoss's unique fingerpicking style and moving vocals have entertained audiences from blues clubs and concert halls to the Philadelphia Folk Festival. From 2007-2009 he opened shows for B.B. King and Etta James in theaters across the country. He has performed and recorded with many highly regarded artists including David Bromberg, Taj Mahal, James Taylor, Paul Butterfield, and Howlin' Wolf.

Dave Cambest Presents: Grant Peeples

Grant Peeples has been a keen observer of the American condition for five decades, ever since a friend introduced him to the music of Bob Dylan. Through many years on the road, running a night club/music venue in Tallahassee, and after a ten-year stint on an isolated island off the coast of Nicaragua, Peeples turned to writing with a vengeance. He wrote poetry and songs that turned a critical eye on American culture and identity, the very definition of contemporary folk music.

He is the recipient of the Focus Foundation Award for Creative Excellence, which cited the "humor, compassion and wisdom of his songs," and his "unflinching social insight and cultural acuity." Grant tours coast to coast has been a regular performer at The Woody Guthrie Folk Festival, the 30A Songwriters Festival, and The Florida Folk Festival. In June he makes his debut at the prestigious Kerrville Folk Festival.

January 2019 marked a second tour in The Netherlands, where FolkForum.nl described him "...a pure storyteller, in the best American folk tradition..." and his show "...one of those gems that you will remember for a long time..." Grant has just released his 12th studio album, A Murder of Songs.




